According to the 2024 Chinese Retail Book Market Report issued by OpenBook, the overall

Chinese book retail market was valued at 15.5 billion USD. Children's books account for the

largest proportion of the total sales of books, reaching 28.16%. This dynamic market is fueled

by an impressive readership of **367 million** minors, covering a wide range of interests and age

groups. Children's literature dominates 35% of the market, while categories like non-fiction

and books focused on mental health are also gaining ground as parents seek more varied

educational content for their children.

Entering the Chinese market offers access to a vast and diverse audience supported by a well-

established publishing infrastructure. As the leading Asia-Pacific fair dedicated to children's

books and content, CCBF provides an essential platform for international publishers to navigate

the market, connect with local distributors, and stay informed on the latest trends. Since 2018,

its collaboration with the Bologna Children's Book Fair (BCBF) has positioned CCBF as a key

hub for **rights trading**, **publishing partnerships**, and **content innovation** on a global scale.
