





THE 62ND BOLOGNA CHILDREN'S BOOK FAIR

BOP - Bologna Prize for the Best Children's Publishers of the Year: the winners of the 2025 edition

Created by Bologna Children's Book Fair in collaboration with the Italian Publishers Association (AIE) and the International Publishers Association (IPA) on the occasion of the 50th anniversary of the Fair, every year the **BOP** - **Bologna Prize for the Best Children's Publishers of the Year** acknowledges the best publishers around the world.

The winners are selected by the publishers themselves, who vote for the publishing houses that have stood out over the last year for their innovation, creativity and the quality of their editorial choices in each of the six areas of the world: Africa; Asia; Europe; North America; Caribbean, Central and South America; Oceania.

The award ceremony for the **thirteenth edition** of the award was held in the evening of **Monday 31 March 2025** as part of the celebrations to mark the start of the Fair's 62st edition.

The winners are:

AFRICA

Imagnary House (**South Africa**): Imagnary House is a publisher and developer of creative children's and young-adult intellectual property. It was founded in 2015 after noticing a gap in Africa for authentic and high-quality children's and YA stories.

ASIA

Everafter Books - Beijing Everafter Culture Development Co., Ltd (China): Everafter Books was founded in 2015 with a mission statement of "publishing high-quality books for children 0-12 years old and nurturing them with exceptional content". Over the past 9 years, Everafter has published over 600 titles with extremely thoughtful and aesthetic values, many of which have won nation-wide awards and have frequented in the most prestigious children's book selection lists in China.
